

10x10 Steering Committee Role Description

- Involvement in this committee is strictly on a voluntary basis.
- All members of the steering committee report to the Theatre in Education Director.
- The committee will meet at Waverley Resource Library the third Thursday of each month from 6:30-7:30pm, starting in November 2023 until the completion of the festival.
- Primary Responsibilities:
 - Seek sponsorship funding for the festival.
 - Assist in the planning and execution of key events in the 10x10 calendar including, but not limited to: workshops, auditions, festival kick off, tech & dress rehearsals, final performances.
- All final decisions on the running of 10x10 are to be approved by the Theatre in Education Director and Magnus Theatre.
- Due to the nature of this role, members of the steering committee cannot be involved in the 10x10 Short Play Festival as either Playwright, Director, or Actor. Committee members may assist backstage or as advisors to directors selected for the festival.
- Each member of the steering committee is entitled to one complimentary ticket to the 10x10 opening night Gala.
